

KidSIM Fellowship in Simulation Education and Research

EXPECTATIONS and REQUIREMENTS

1. Education

- Attendance at all formal academic sessions (joint KidSIM and SickKids curriculum)
 - Every 1st Tuesday of the month
 - Every 3rd Monday of the month
- Development or review/update minimum of 12 simulation scenarios over the year
 - Including obtaining feedback & review, piloting and upload to the KidSIM library
- Facilitate a minimum of 4-6 hours a week (on average) of simulation teaching at ACH.
 - This represents a minimum of 2 sessions per week.
- Facilitate a minimum 6 sessions of mobile education a year
- Attend all the Fellowship Coaching Day & present one session towards end of fellowship
 - Every 1st Wednesday of the month

2. Research

- Preparing ethics approval for one research/scholarly project
- Recruitment for one research/scholarly project
- Attendance at all KidSIM-ASPIRE meetings
- Present and/or publish one research/scholarly project

3. Courses and Rounds

- Attendance at all KidSIM rounds/visiting professors
- Attendance at all ASSET courses
 - Initially as participants and later as facilitators
 - ASSET Foundations, Advanced, Co-debriefing, Peer Coaching
- Attendance at all PSEOC meetings

4. Mentorship

- Help orient, support and mentor junior simulation trainee (elective resident/students)

5. Evaluation

- Attendance at quarterly review with the Fellowship Program Director
- Collect written feedback from co-facilitators following a teaching session
